Candidates would work alongside six other skilled behavior analysts in a strong ABA community. This is a full-time position (35 hours per week) that follows a school calendar, including a six-week summer program.

Candidates must possess:

- A desire to work with individuals with disabilities
- Strong documentation skills
- Willingness to learn and apply new skills
- Dependability

Expectations of Board Certified Behavior Analyst:

- Perform assessments of behavior and develop behavior plans.
- Train staff in the implementation of behavior plans and conduct regular fidelity checks.
- Monitor treatment plans and schedule interdisciplinary meetings to review progress.
- Work collaboratively with families and other service providers.
- Assist with staff and parent training.
